Github is a hosting service:

- For open source projects
- For other projects (for \$)
- Stores the central repository of projects
- Stores individual people's "forks"
- Facilitates the movement of patches (=sets of commits) between repositories

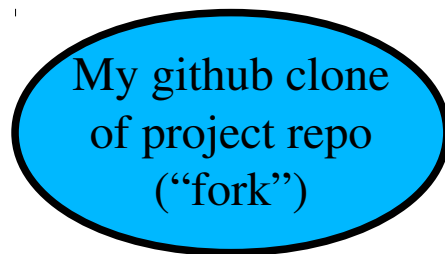

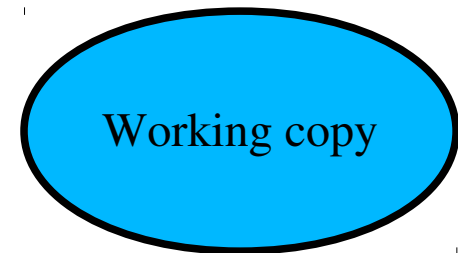
